BIM is making a name for itself on the architecture, engineering and construction scene. It is revolutionising the way buildings, infrastructures and technical networks are planned, designed, built and managed. It makes information clearer and adds value at each stage of the process.

WHAT IS BIM?

BIM, or Building Information Modelling, includes all the processes implemented in organising & structuring information for a construction project. It is used to digitally simulate a virtual model of a building.

The digital prototype obtained provides a technical, standardised and shared database. It contains building parts and pieces, the physical, technical and functional characteristics of these elements, as well as how they interact with each other.

This digital model makes for a better collaborative approach between different construction project actors facilitating design and improving project analysis.

The initial feedback has been very positive and European governments all agree on the advantages offered by BIM. In the wake of the UK in 2016, France and Germany are on the verge of making BIM obligatory for all major government-backed projects. They will be joining The Netherlands, Denmark, Finland and Norway who already require BIM to be used for certain projects.
